## SEC. 2. REQUESTS BY CBO OF INFORMATION FROM EXECU TIVE AGENCIES.

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 201(d) of the Congres4 sional Budget and Impoundment Control Act of 1974 (2
5 U.S.C. 601(d)) is amended—

6 (1) by striking "The Director is authorized"
7 and inserting "(1) The Director is authorized";

8 (2) by striking "(other than material the disclo-9 sure of which would be a violation of law)" and in-10 serting "(with or without written agreement) pro-11 vided that the Director maintains the level of con-12 fidentiality required by law of the department, agen-13 cy, establishment, or regulatory agency or commis-14 sion from which it is obtained in accordance with 15 section 203(e)"; and

16 (3) by adding at the end the following:

17 "(2) No provision of law enacted after the date of the enactment of the Congressional Budget Office Data 18 19 Sharing Act shall be construed to supersede, limit, or oth-20 erwise modify the authority of the Director to obtain any 21 material under this subsection unless such provision spe-22 cifically provides, by specific reference to this paragraph, that such authority is to be superseded, limited, or other-23 wise modified.". 24

25 (b) REPORT.—Not later than one year after the date26 of the enactment of this Act, the Director of the Congres-

sional Budget Office shall submit, to the chairs of the 1 2 Committees on the Budget of the House of Representatives and the Senate, a report listing any request for infor-3 mation pursuant to a written agreement under section 4 201(d) of the Congressional Budget and Impoundment 5 Control Act of 1974 (2 U.S.C. 601(d)), as amended by 6 7 subsection (a) of this Act, made to any department, agency, or establishment of the executive branch of Govern-8 ment or any regulatory agency or commission of the Gov-9 ernment and any challenges faced accessing information 10 11 under such section.
