July 23, 2019 The Science Coalition Commends Deal to Raise Budget Caps

WASHINGTON – The Science Coalition (TSC) today issued the following statement after a tentative deal to raise the budget caps was reached between congressional leaders and the Trump administration:

"Consistent federal funding for key research agencies is critical to America's long-term success and ability to compete globally. The unique partnership between our country's research universities and these federal agencies is the engine of American innovation. Stable, predictable funding enables university researchers to focus on the discoveries that will strengthen our economy and encourage technological advancements. A budget framework for the next two years – that moves us past the threat of future sequestration – is a win for American science. We urge Congress to appropriate the necessary funding to demonstrate America's commitment to this endeavor."

TSC recently released a state-by-state <u>analysis</u> of post-sequestration cuts to core federal research agencies' state-level spending. Without a deal on federal budget caps, cuts to non-defense discretionary spending and defense basic research for federal agencies would have totaled more than <u>\$5.1 billion</u>.

A recent <u>poll</u> from The Science Coalition found that eight in 10 voters, across party lines, support the federal government using taxpayer funds to invest in scientific research.
